## Change of Season, Change of Clothes

We would like to remind parents that since, fall/winter is here, please bring in a spare set of clothing for your child that is appropriate for the season. Make sure to label the clothing with your child's name. This helps to avoid confusion/mix-ups if children have the same designs or styles.

We do try to get the children out daily, so make sure your child has hat, mittens/gloves, boots and snow pants. If your child does not have these items to wear, they will still go outside with their class.



## Child Absence Policy

Parents should notify the Center by phone (636-8051) by 10:00 am that their child will be absent for the day. If no call has been received, a phone call may be made to your home inquiring as to why your child is not at the Center. If there is no answer, a message may be left on your home phone and/or cell phone and documented at the Center. Because the Center holds a spot open for your child according to the schedule you submit, you must pay for those days a child is absent from care unless you choose to use vacation/sick time. Repeat offenses, 2 or more times will result in a \$5.00 fee per occurrence. Consistent failure to notify the Center of a child's absence may result in dismissal from the Center.

#### **Annual Registration Fee**

The annual registration fee of \$60 per family will be billed to your childcare account either the second or third week in January. Any family who enrolled in September thru December 2019 should not receive an additional registration fee. If you do, please let Lorie or Becca know so we can correct your account.

## Sick Policy

"Stay At Home" Policy: SE-CDC wants to ensure the health and safety of all its children and staff. This means that you will be asked to keep your child at home or make other arrangements for child care in the event that he/she is ill. Please do not be angry or upset with our staff if you are asked to come and pick up a sick child or are asked to keep your child at home until he or she is well again. If your child becomes ill during the night, please do not send him/her to school the next day.

If your child displays any of the following symptoms, they should not be brought to the Center:

- Nausea or vomiting
- Stomach ache or cramps
- Fever (greater than 101 degrees)
- Severe cough or difficulty breathing
  - Diarrhea
- Communicable disease during the time in which the disease is contagious.
  - Suspicious rashes (until seen by a physician)
  - Sore throat
